



COVID-19 Health Screening and Temperature Check Policy Customers/Participants

Effective Monday, June 1st, 2020, all customers/participants attending on track activities will be screened for respiratory symptoms and have their body temperature taken as a precautionary measure to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

Every customer/participant will be screened, including having their temperature taken, when arriving onto the Sonoma Raceway property. Customers/participants should report to the Old Admin building upon arrival and prior to entering any other areas of the property.

Each customer and participant will be screened privately by the Screening Manager on Duty using a touchless forehead thermometer. While conducting the temperatures, managers must be wearing proper PPE to mitigate exposure. Customers/participants are required to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth during the health screening and at all times when on the Sonoma Raceway property. The customer/participant's temperature and answers to respiratory symptom questions will be confidential.

After the customer/participant has completed their health screening and is cleared to attend on track activities, they will be given a wristband to wear while on property and that must be presented to the guard on duty in order to enter and move about the property. Once the customer/participant has received their wristband, they will be directed to Guest Services where they may check in for their event.

A customer/participant who has a fever at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, or who is experiencing coughing or shortness of breath will not be allowed to enter the property. The customer/participants temperature and answers to respiratory symptom questions will be documented and the record will be maintained as a private medical record. The employee is encouraged to self-quarantine for 14 days per CDC guidelines and should contact their doctor or use telemedicine if concerned about the symptoms. A customer/participant whose temperature equals or exceeds 100.4°F will not be permitted to enter the Company's premises for at least 14 days from the date of the temperature check and must be subject to temperature check before being permitted entry after the exclusion period.

A customer/participant who experiences fever and/or respiratory symptoms while home should not attend any event at Sonoma Raceway.
