### **Car Corral**

We welcome you to join us at the Car Corral, located at the Turn 3 overhang. You will enter Sonoma Raceway at the main gate and follow signs for the Car Corral. When you arrive at the car corral, you will see an SRO tent for check-in/registration for the parade lap (Saturday and Sunday only). You'll be in close proximity to a shuttle stop that can take you down into the lower paddock, where you have full access to roam and see all the amazing GT machinery. Be sure to check out our fan zone and some of our activations - Don't forget to snag an EBOOST for extra energy!

Registration: When you arrive, register under the SRO tent. Please have your driver's license and valid insurance.

## **Damages to Sonoma Raceway Park Property**

Anyone who causes damage to Sonoma Raceway property, including track, equipment, buildings, vehicles, fences, safety systems, grass, and landscaped areas, will be held responsible for all costs relating to replacement or repair.

## **Car Corral Pass**

Your Car Corral pass includes entry for the driver, designated parking & eligibility for the Parade Laps (Sat & Sun). If you are going to have any passengers with you, they MUST have a general admission ticket—kids 12 and under enter for free.

When you arrive at the Sonoma Raceway MAIN GATE, you will show your digital ticket and you will proceed to the Car Corral area located under the Turn 3 overhang. When you arrive at the Car Corral area, we will give you your sticker (below). Please position it on the left (passenger) side, at the top of your windshield.







































# **Parade Lap Guidelines**

Please be on time for the mandatory Drivers Meeting. You will NOT be able to participate without attending. A helmet is not necessary for the Parade Lap.

### DO

- Follow the Lead Car: A pace car will lead the parade, and it's crucial that you maintain a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you.
- Keep a Steady Pace: While we encourage you to enjoy the experience, it's important to maintain a steady and consistent pace. Sudden acceleration or deceleration can create unsafe conditions for other drivers.
- Use Your Signals: When entering or exiting the track, be sure to use your turn signals to communicate your intentions clearly to other drivers.
- Windows Down.

### **DON'T**

- **No Passing:** This is a parade, NOT a race. Passing other vehicles is strictly prohibited.
- No Burnouts or Excessive Revving: While we understand the temptation, burnouts & excessive revving can damage the track surface.
- No Stopping on Track: Unless instructed by a course marshal or in case of an emergency, do not stop your vehicle on the track. This can create a hazardous situation for other drivers.
- No Alcohol or Substance Use: Driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance is strictly prohibited.
- No Distractions: Keep your focus on the road and avoid any distractions, such as using your phone or engaging in other activities while driving.
- No Rubber Banding.
- No minors are allowed to drive. 18 and up.































## Traffic in and out of the Car Corral & Track

You will need to sign two waivers in order to be eligible for parade laps. One will be a paper waiver to be completed once you're on site. The second waiver you can fill out now, and it will save on your phone as a text to make your registration process smoother. Please visit **THIS LINK** to complete the SRO waiver.

Traffic in and out of the car corral will be limited throughout the event. After the drivers meeting, we will make two lines and depart in order as instructed by the SRO staff member. Anyone inside the car MUST sign waivers and show bracelets when entering the track.
