2025 RACE RECAP

William Sawalich edged out Christian Eckes and Alon Day in a dramatic three-wide finish to win the General Tire 200 ARCA Menards Series West race Friday at Sonoma Raceway, securing his first victory of the 2025 season.

Sawalich, who competes full-time in the Xfinity Series with Joe Gibbs Racing, now has four wins as an ARCA West driver.

"That was definitely our race," said Sawalich. "It just sucks that it had to happen that way. We did what we could to get our car into Victory Lane."

The 67-lap race on the 1.99-mile road concluded with Sawalich holding off a strong challenge from Eckes, making his series debut with Bill McAnally Racing, and road-course specialist Day. The trio crossed the finish line separated by mere inches with Sawalich edging out Eckes by 0.067 seconds.

Sawalich, also the pole winner, led all 50 laps, though three lead changes marked the final lap.

Eckes came all the way back into the mix after finding himself at the rear or a pack after a mid-race spinout. Eckes and Sawalich traded a handful of bumps throughout the 12-turn circuit on the last lap and continued the physicality into the final split second. Sawalich even bumped into the wall in the final feet into the finish line but still managed to outlast a charging Eckes

Trevor Huddleston, the points leader entering the event, finished fourth, followed by Tyler Reif in fifth. Eric Nascimento, Corey Day, Kyle Keller, Tanner Reif and Jeff Anton rounded out the top 10.

The race featured a scheduled caution near lap 32, allowing teams to strategize under modified live pitting rules, which prohibited fuel additions before lap 20 and restricted tire changes to emergencies. Sawalich capitalized on a strong restart after the caution to maintain his lead.

NOTEWORTHY

ARCA Menards Series – The General Tire 200 at Sonoma Raceway remains one of the premier road course events on the ARCA West schedule. Held on the 10-turn, 1.99-mile layout, the event has consistently drawn top talent from across the racing spectrum. The event has seen a mix of series regulars and NASCAR national series drivers compete, with several Cup and Xfinity drivers making winning appearances. ... Chase Briscoe kicked off the current era of dominance by Cup-affiliated drivers in 2021, leading every lap in route to victory in an overtime finish driving for Stewart-Haas Racing. ... In 2022, it was Jake Drew who took center stage. The Sunrise Ford Racing driver started from pole and led 48 of 56 laps in a time-shortened race, using strategy and race management to secure the win in the fifth race of the season. ... The 2023 edition saw Ryan Preece claim his first ARCA Menards Series West win, once again for Stewart-Haas Racing. Preece led 50 of 64 laps and overcame a late charge from Landen Lewis, who exited after a crash on Lap 47. Sammy Smith and Riley Herbst completed the podium. ... Sam Mayer stole the spotlight in 2024, taking command midway through the race and leading the final 37 laps. The race went into NASCAR overtime, extending it to 67 laps. Mayer, driving for Sigma Performance Services, held off Tyler Reif and Sean Hingorani in the closing laps. William Sawalich, who led 21 laps early, rebounded to finish fourth after an incident. ... The race has become a proving ground for young talent and a test of discipline for seasoned veterans, with few able to escape the technical demands of Sonoma's road course unscathed. ... Stewart-Haas Racing drivers have won two of the last four races, while Sigma Performance Services and Sunrise Ford Racing each have one win. ... Among active drivers, Mayer and Hingorani have top-five finishes in their most recent starts, with Mayer's 2024 win his second career ARCA West victory. ... Sonoma remains the only road course on the ARCA Menards West calendar where Cup and O'Reilly Auto Parts Series regulars frequently drop in, making the General Tire 200 one of the most unpredictable and entertaining events of the season.
