CREDENTIALS

- **Essential** – Media, team and manufacturer public relations representatives and sanctioning body officials can request credentials for the Denso NHRA Nationals at Sonoma Raceway using the Speedway Motorsports, LLC credential request system. If you would like to request credentials, please visit the Speedway Motorsports Credentials System website **PICK UP AT MEDIA CENTER**
- **NHRA Weekend Pass** - Get the full race weekend experience including Friday night nitro qualifying under the lights and Elimination Sunday where we crown new champions!
- **NHRA Restricted Area:** Guests or staff needing to pick up a restricted area pass will need to go to NHRA credentials. Restricted Area passes must be approved in advance

Sonoma Raceway Credentials

- We extend credentials to photographers and media on assignment from accredited media outlets and may not credential freelance photographers, unless approved by Sonoma Raceway personnel. Freelance photographers are more than welcome to come out to the raceway or any of our events and shoot from the spectator-only areas.
- **Service Pass** – Provides access for “non-essential” track workers (concessions, gate staff, suite attendants, etc...). Good for all non-NHRA secured areas (grandstands/infield camping) Does not provide a seat and does not include permanent parking in Fan Zone area. Drop off/Pick up allowed, and permanent parking in Lot 2 is advised. Good for entire weekend.
- **Stickers** – There are no additional stickers needed for Victory Lane, Media Center or any other location around Sonoma Raceway.

Hardcards

- All media who do not have a NHRA hard card must have a NHRA “Essential” credential to access the garages.

DRESS CODE/CONDUCT

We kindly ask that team members not wear clothing which shows an allegiance to a particular team or driver.

Professional attire is required. Team members should always conduct themselves in a professional manner and refrain from seeking autographs or taking photos with drivers, team owners or other team members.

Inclement Weather: You should report to work prepared for any type of weather. Plan to bring extra clothing, e.g., rain jackets, shoes, and an additional layer of warm, dry clothing.

Accessories: All caps (event/uniform hats ONLY) should be worn properly, with the bill or brim faced forward. Earrings may only be worn in the ear; any other visible piercings should be removed before reporting to work.

Electronic Devices: Electronic devices are prohibited while at your assigned event post. Cell phones may only be used to contact your supervisor or in case of an emergency.

DRONES

The use of drones or any other unmanned aircraft systems ("UAS") is prohibited unless approved in advance in writing by senior management from Sonoma Raceway.

ELEVATORS

Located near the Suite Check-In behind the Main Grandstands with access to the Suite-level, race control level and top of the Main Grandstands level.

GOLF CARTS/ATVs

For the safety of all guests, golf carts, hover boards, quads, UTVs, side-by-sides, scooters, skateboards, Segways, dirt bikes, motorized furniture, or any other similar personal transportation devices are strictly prohibited on Sonoma Raceway property.

- Pedal-assist e-bikes are allowed in camping areas only (e-bikes must have pedals). They may not be ridden to access seating areas or the Fan Zone. Pedal-assist e-bikes will not be allowed to cross Highway 121 from the 50 Acres Campground to the road course.
- Street legal, licensed motorcycles with off-road or dual-sport tires are not allowed on raceway property. Only licensed motorcycles with street tires are allowed (even if tires are DOT approved, if they are nobby or stubby and capable of going off-road they are not allowed).

*The raceway reserves the right to restrict the use of any vehicle on-property.

If any of these vehicles are brought to the raceway, you will be asked to impound the vehicle prior to parking in your

camping space. Impound is located through Gate 6 in the 50 Acres Campground. If guests refuse to impound their vehicle, they will be turned away and not allowed to enter the facility. Single-person electronic convenience vehicles, built specifically for guests with disabilities, are permitted.

Impounded vehicles can be picked up Sunday after the race and on Monday morning. Exact pick-up times will be provided when you arrive at the campground. When picking up your impounded vehicle, you must arrive in your RV prepared to leave the campground. You will not be allowed to return to your camping space.

Off-road motorcycles with valid license plates will be impounded for the weekend. These are motorcycles that are clearly built for off-road activities with off-road, knobby tires. Only licensed motorcycles built to drive on the street, with street tires, can enter the raceway. GRANDSTAND INFORMATION

Anyone entering the grandstands must have a ticket or wristband. For re-entry into the grandstands, patrons must have their tickets exit scanned before **exiting** the facility. All seats are assigned.

LOST AND FOUND

MOTORCYCLES

Motorcycle riders should enter through Gate 1 (main entrance). After passing through the gate, you will make a left turn up the hill to Lot 1.

PARKING

Sonoma Raceway offers **FREE** parking in the following lots:

- Lots 4, 5, 11, 12, 13, and 14. Enter through Gate 7
- Accessible Lot
 - ADA parking is available through Gate 1. Guests with disabilities attending the event, will need to bring their ADA parking placard, paperwork showing their name and placard number, and a valid driver's license.
- Rideshare Lot

Pre-order your Uber and Lyft rides to avoid long wait times. Pick-up and drop-off areas are located at the 50 Acres Campground, north end, at the Gate 6 entrance.

All vehicles trying to enter restricted areas must present the required credential by attaching it to the windshield or showing the mobile credential to the guest service/security staff before entering. Listed below are the official vehicle credentials for the 2026 NASCAR race weekend at SR:

Parking Passes

- **Admin** – Provides access to the Administration Building parking lot.
- **Lot 1** – Located at the Sonoma Raceway Karting Center. Provides parking access and privileges to the Lot 1 Parking Lot.
- **Lot 2** – Located next to the administration and Media Lots, provides parking access and privileges to the Lot 2 Parking Lot.
- **Media Lot** – Provides parking access and privileges to the Media Center Parking Lot.
- **Media Reserve:** On Friday and Saturday, provides parking access and privileges to the Media Reserve Lot next to the Forum and Turn 1 Club. On Sunday, this lot turns into a Paddock Parking Pass with access to park in the Paddock.
- **TV Compound** – Provides parking access to the TV Compound Parking Lot. Issued to members of the TV, radio, and broadcast production teams.

PETS

Only pets for seeing impaired guests or for other ADA purposes are allowed into the raceway. Pets are permitted in camping areas, but must remain on a leash or in a harness at all times.

Please note: Trained service animals are allowed in competitor pit and seating areas. Service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness at all times.

PROHIBITED ITEMS (GRANDSTAND)

Existing raceway policies will continue to be enforced and are as follows:

The following items are NOT allowed at the raceway:

- Aerosol cans (with the exception of sunscreen, sun block, hand sanitizer, and bug spray)
- Alcohol
- Glass or ceramic containers of any kind
- Displays of the Confederate Flag
- Drones
- Dry Ice
- E-Bikes
- Foam or hard-sided coolers regardless of size
- Fireworks/Sky Lanterns
- Frisbees, Balloons or any other Projectile
- Inline Skates/Skateboards/Bicycles/Hover Boards
- Laser Pointers, Noise Makers and Air Horns
- Lawn Chairs and Stadium-Type Seats with Legs (all cushions must sit flat against your seat)
- Selfie Sticks
- Tripods and monopods that are either solid or collapsible
- Umbrellas in Seating Areas

- Wagons
- Weapons, including, but not limited to, guns, knives, stun guns, and pepper spray

All items and persons are subject to search and seizure. You can choose to take prohibited items back to your car or surrender them at security. Once an item is surrendered it cannot be reclaimed.

Prohibited Activities

The following activities are not allowed on the raceway property:

- Solicitation for Donations
- Unauthorized Selling or Buying of Event Tickets
- Unapproved Selling of Merchandise or Services
- Unapproved Distribution of any Item
- Unapproved Entertaining (organized concerts not approved by the raceway are prohibited)
