#### 2024 GUIDELINES

#### **Vehicle Guidelines**

- All vehicles must pass basic NHRA technical/safety inspection. Tech cards are to be completed with full name and address.
- All vehicles are limited to a maximum of 114.9 decibels as measured at the starting line.
- All categories will be contested over 1/4 mile (weather permitting) with the exception of High School/Junior Street
- Pre-2008 vehicles running quicker than 11.50 (7.35 1/8 mile) must have an NHRA approved rollbar. ALL convertibles quicker than 13.50 (8.25 1/8 mile) are required to have an NHRA approved rollbar.
- Pre-2014 vehicles running quicker than 10.00 (6.40 1/8 mile) or faster than 135 mph and all vehicles running quicker than 9.00 (5.75 1/8 mile) require a full roll cage and a certified chassis.
- All vehicles must be equipped with a coolant overflow bottle and a battery tie down. If the battery is relocated from the stock location, a shutoff switch is required.
- Anyone concerned about meeting vehicle requirements should reach out to the Dragstrip Manager, or consult the NHRA rulebook (available for purchase or free download) at NHRA Racer.

#### **General Pit Area Guidelines**

- Alcohol and drugs are NOT permitted in the pit area on Wednesday Nights.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- The speed limit on the return road is 15 MPH; the speed limit in the pit area and staging lines is 5MPH.
- Pit vehicles (golf carts, scooters, quads, minibikes, etc) are not permitted on Wednesday Nights. Mobility scooters and other ADA type vehicles permitted.
- Persons under age 16 are not permitted in restricted areas between staging lanes or race track and may not
  operate any vehicles (including bicycles or scooters) at any time.

<u>Driver Guidelines</u>	Motorcycle Rider Guidelines
<ul> <li>ALL drivers are required to wear full-length pants, shirt with sleeves (no tank top), and closed toe shoes with socks. SHORTS ARE NOT PERMITTED.</li> <li>Drivers of vehicles quicker than 14.00 (8.60 1/8 mile) must have an approved (Snell SA 2015 or newer) helmet.</li> <li>Drivers of vehicles quicker than 11.50 (7.35 1/8 mile) must have an approved racing jacket.</li> <li>Drivers of vehicles quicker than 10.00 seconds (6.40 1/8 mile) and faster than 135 MPH are required to have an NHRA competition license, and appropriate safety equipment described in the NHRA rulebook.</li> <li>A valid driver's license is required for all categories except Junior Street</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Motorcycle riders must have an approved full face helmet, leather jacket, leather boots or shoes that cover top of ankle, and leather gloves.</li> <li>Motorcycle riders running 120 MPH or faster must have full all-leathers or SFI Spec 40.1/2 suit.</li> <li>Riders of bikes/quads quicker than 10.00 seconds (6.40 1/8 mile) are required to have an NHRA competition license, as well as appropriate safety equipment as described in the NHRA rulebook.</li> </ul>

# HIGH SCHOOL/JUNIOR STREET

LANES

0 - 00

- Junior Street will follow NHRA Junior Street rules available on nhraracer.com
- Junior Street drivers must license prior to competition, driver and passenger must have helmets
- Junior Street and High School will contest eliminations separately
- High School students must be age 16 with a valid driver's license
- Junior Street 1/8 mile 9.0 dial in or slower, High School 1/4 mile 12.00 dial in or slower
- True Start, Full tree, optional staging

# OPEN TEST/GRUDGE

LANES

1 - 4

- Non-elimination category, will run throughout the evening
- Vehicle and driver must meet NHRA safety requirements for ET
- Some vehicles may run solo passes at Race Director's discretion
- Full tree, optional staging
- Motorcycle test/tune will run at the end of motorcycle category

## STREET BRACKET

Lanes **5 - 8** 

Street legal vehicles 11.60 and slower with DOT approved tire

True Start, Full Tree, Optional Staging

#### GEAR JAMMER BRACKET

LANES

9 - 10

- Street legal vehicles 11.60 and slower with DOT approved tire
- True Start, Full Tree, Optional Staging
- Manual transmission required

#### MOTORCYCLE BRACKET

LANE

11

- Motorcycles running 8.50 and slower.
- .500 full tree or .400 pro tree at rider's choice.
- Category laddered prior to eliminations
- Open Test/Grudge available, will run at end of category

## COMP BRACKET

LANES

12 - 13

- Full bodied vehicles 8.50 and slower, minimum dial 13.99
- Slick tires permitted
- Delay box permitted (No Crosstalk)
- True Start, Full tree, optional staging

## **Ј**АСКРОТ

LANES

14 - 15

- Vehicles 8.50 and slower.
- True Start, Full tree, optional staging, Cross talk permitted
- Full racing electronics permitted.
- Additional fee collected by lane steward prior to eliminations.
- Category laddered prior to eliminations.
